IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Read the safety precautions of this booklet carefully before attempting to assemble, install, operate or maintain the product described. Protect yourself and others by observing all safety information. Failure to comply with instructions could result in personal injury and/or property damage. If you are unsure about anything regarding your pedestal fan or these instructions, please contact Omega Altise on 1300 795 572 in Australia or (09) 415 6000 in New Zealand before operating your appliance.

- 1. Read all instructions carefully before using the pedestal fan.
- 2. Use this pedestal fan only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electrical shock, or injury to persons. Do not modify this appliance. Do not try to repair this appliance there are no user serviceable parts within.
- 3. Remove the packaging and ensure that the appliance is undamaged. In case of doubt do not use the appliance and contact Omega Altise Service. Do not let children play with any parts of the packaging.
- 4. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience or knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance. Extreme caution is necessary when the pedestal fan is used by or near children or individuals with decreased mental and physical capacity and whenever the pedestal fan is left operating unattended.
- 5. Before you use the appliance, check if the voltage marked on the rating label corresponds to the mains in your home. The appliance must be connected to a grounded power supply.
- 6. Do not use this appliance with a programmer, timer or any other device that switches the appliance on automatically, since a fire risk exists if the appliance is covered or positioned incorrectly.
- 7. Do not pull the power cord to disconnect with the power source. Always grasp the plug to pull it out.
- 8. Do not run power cords under rugs or other combustible materials. Do not place power cords in areas where they can be a tripping hazard. Do not operate directly below a power outlet.
- 9. Do not insert any objects into the appliance as it may cause an electric shock or fire or damage to the appliance. Do not block or tamper with the appliance in any manner while it is in operation. To prevent a possible fire, do not cover the appliance in any manner. Do not place on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
- 10. Do not leave the appliance unattended. Always unplug the appliance when not in use. Take care that it is not obstructed when oscillating.

WARNING:

The Function Switch should not be used as the sole means of disconnecting power. Always unplug the power cord before servicing or moving the appliance.

- 11. Keep materials such as hair, net curtains, tablecloths & clothes away from the openings of the pedestal fan, as material may be sucked into the appliance causing injury, damage to property or the appliance.
- 12. The appliance has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. It must NOT be used in potentially dangerous locations such as flammable, explosive, chemical-laden, corrosive, salty or wet atmospheres. This appliance is intended for general indoor domestic use ONLY.
- 13. This appliance is not intended for use in wet or damp locations. Never locate it where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
- 14. Do not use the pedestal fan outdoors. Do not use close to windows or in direct sunlight.
- 15. Always place the appliance on flat, stable surfaces before use. Always place the appliance vertically on its base.
- 16. Ensure that the fan is switched off or unplugged from supply mains before removing the guard.

WARNING: To avoid danger of electric shock, unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its Service Agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard. In order to avoid overheating, do not cover the appliance. Do not use the appliance in the immediate surrounding of a bath, shower or swimming pool.

It is important that you retain these instructions, proof of purchase as well as other important documents about this product for future reference. Due to continual product development, Omega Altise reserves the right to alter specifications or appearances without notice.

Dispose of packaging responsibly – recycle where facilities are available.




TECHNICAL DETAILS AND PARTS

Model: OP408B Pedestal fan with remote control.

Power: 220-240V 50Hz, 60W.

Dimensions (H(max)xWxD): 1300x420x445mm



INSTALLATION

- 1. Carefully remove the parts of the appliance from the plastic bags and the carton, and unwind the cord to its full length.
- 2. Overturn the main body and insert the inner column.
- 3. Turn to adjust the screw holes and lock by the inner column screw.
- 4. Put the outer column and base ring on.
- 5. Put the base and base nut on. Lock the base by turning the nut clockwise.
- 6. Overturn the main body and place on a flat surface. Put the rear grille and grille nut in the motor axis. -Lock the rear grille by turning the nut clockwise.
- 7. -Put the fan blade on the motor axis.
- 8. -Fix it by fitting the concave area. Then put on and turn the blade nut anti-clockwise to lock the fan blade. Put the grille ring on the front grille with the lock downward.
- 9. -Pull and open the grille ring lock. Put the front grille with ring on the rear grille.
- 10. -After fitted the grilles, close the grille ring lock and install the grille ring lock screw to finish.

OPERATION

Place this appliance on a flat surface and connect to the power outlet. The display will show the current temperature (°C) and switch to standby mode. Press the power key once, this appliance will start operating in low speed with normal wind mode. The display will show "01"(speed) and "normal". And the display will show the current temperature & wind speed as cycle.

Wind speed setting

When operating, press the wind speed key can adjust the wind speed in 3 levels. And the display will show the wind speed: speed 01(low) - 02(medium) - 03(high) - 01(low) - cycle.

Mode setting: When operating, default using normal model. Press the mode key can adjust the wind mode as cycle.

Normal mode: keep operating at same wind speed.

Natural mode: auto adjust wind speed as rhythm to pretend natural wind.

Sleep mode: the fan will blow slowly and quietly, suitable for use during sleep.

Oscillation setting

This appliance can set individual up&down, left&right or 3D oscillation. Oscillation is off in default setting. Press the oscillation key can set this function as cycle.

Swing: null(no OSC) – left/right – up/down – 3D OSC – null(no OSC) - cycle

Timer setting

Max. 12hours timer is available. When operating. Press timer key can set the shutdown timer as cycle. The display will shown timer by hour. When the timer countdown finished, this appliance will stop operate and switch to standby mode. Timer: null(no timer) – 01..... cycle



Manual adjust tilt-angle

Soft touch only is need to adjust the grille backward or pulling onward to the desired fan angle. Before adjust the tilt-angle, please shutdown and unplug this appliance.

Manual adjust the column height

Make sure every parts are well installed before adjust the height. Hold the connector by hand, then loose the column lock by turning anti-clockwise.

Hold the column and lift/low the connector can adjust the height. Keep holding the connector after adjusted .Lock the extend column by turning the column lock clockwise.

Remote control

All the keys on the remote control correspond to the keys on the control panel

Open the back cover of remote control can replace the battery (2XAAA). Please remind the +/- direction of battery when replace.

Caution:

Battery should be keep out of reach of children.

If battery is swallowed accidentally, please consult a doctor for help immediately.

Do not recharge the battery to avoid accident.

Do not dispose the battery to heat source or nearby.

The battery should be storeage in cool and dry place.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

WARNING:



ALWAYS UNPLUG THE CORD BEFORE MOVING OR SERVICING, DO NOT IMMERSE APPLIANCE IN WATER!

The fan should be cleaned periodically (at least once a month depending on the build-up of dust).

Clean the body of the pedestal fan with a soft damp cloth. Always make sure that the appliance is completely dry before connecting back to the mains supply.

CAUTION: Do not use gasoline, benzene, thinner, harsh cleaners, etc. as they will damage the pedestal fan. NEVER use ALCOHOL OR SOLVENTS.

Remove the front guard and take out the fan blades. Wash under water, rinse & dry. Replace fan blades and front guard. Do not disassemble the fan in any other manner.
